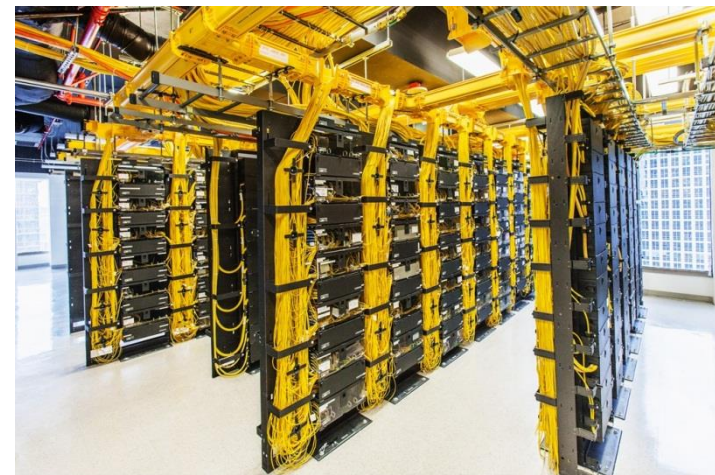
## Who did this?
