Online Safety Bill –


- Codes of Practice

Human elements of security, identity and privacy (OSBill)

- **Security** = Being safe online (Safety by Design)
- **Identity** = Age Assurance/Age Verification



<u>Privacy</u> = Freedom of expression & protecting processing of personal data

- Messaging, online gaming, social media, search,
- virtual and extended reality etc
